Helicopter/Flying Biography:

Having starting my flying career in fixed wing, I flew a 35 hour helicopter conversion course on the pre-governor R22 at Oxford Air Training School in 1989. Since then I have flown extensively round the UK and the rest of the world. Trips have included UK to Berlin in a JetRanger, Portland, ON to Torrance, CA in a group of R22s with Kurt Robinson, UK to Cadiz in Spain by R44 in a party of four helicopters, Samedan (R44) and Courchevel (R22 and R44) Altiports back to the UK, and for Linford Christie's BBC Recordbreakers, flying from John O'Groats to Land's End in an R44. Two further round Britain trips as instructor.

My most ambitious trip was in 1999, when I flew an R44 14000nm through 21 countries via 70 fuel stops from Cambridge, UK to Adelaide, Australia.

I have acted as Chef de la Délégation (appointed by the Helicopter Club of Great Britain), organising and leading a team of 40+ British Team contestants, judges, and supporters to the World Helicopter Championships to Aigen, Austria. The result included a first ever World Championship win for the British Ladies Team. I have won trophies in various HCGB Championships, acted as Championship Director at a British Helicopter Championships, and represented Great Britain in the USA World Helicopter Championships in an R22.

I have mountain flying experience, in Snowdonia, the French Alps (landing at Courchevel), and flying a stranded R44 back to the UK from Samedan, the highest conventional airport in Europe, and in the Blue Mountains, Sydney, Australia.

In 2010/2011 I trained for JAA CPL(H) and FI(H), and have been instructing at Aeromega ever since.

In 2012 I led a party flying two R44s round the Land's End to John O'Groats route for Aeromega.
